‘Manor on the Move’ – 13th July 2007

Dear Parents/Carers

Manor Community College students will be taking part in a sponsored walk on Friday 13th July 2007 to raise money for local charities. The route of ‘Manor on the Move’ will take us out into the countryside along the river Cam, to Bottisham lock and back, approximately ten miles. All staff will either be walking or at marshalling points along the route. This event is staged by students every two years, very few do not complete the route. As a health related activity students will be measuring the number of strides they take and heartbeat at staging points. Sponsorship will be by number of strides taken recorded by pedometer.

During Citizenship and Personal Development lessons students will complete the preparatory work, plotting the route, deciding on which charity to donate to and getting in touch with them. They will design a team logo for their T-shirt and a poster to promote their event. Every student in Years 7, 8 and 9 will take part; we hope they can raise as much money as possible. If they raise £3.00 each or more they will gain free admission to a school disco held in the Autumn Term. There will also be prizes for the most money raised in each year group. A sponsor form is attached. We hope that you can give your support by helping to get as many sponsors as possible.

We will meet at the car park of the Penny Ferry pub, Water Lane in Chesterton (formerly the Pike and Eel). Each tutor group will be registered and start walking at staggered times. They will also be registered at Bottisham lock and when they return. Students will be allowed to go home once they have completed the walk. We can provide transport from Manor to the starting point, and return at the end of the day. Please indicate if you wish your child to be transported to and from the walk.

We hope an enjoyable, healthy and profitable day will be had by all. Please note, that if the event is stopped by severe weather students will be asked to return home safely; we will give much notice as possible.
