

## Prescribed Alterations to Manor Community College

**Notice is hereby given in accordance with section 19(3) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that the Governing Body of Manor Community College intends to make a prescribed alteration to Manor Community College (A Community School) Arbury Road, Cambridge, CB4 2JF.**

**This is the second publication of this Notice. The original published on 17<sup>th</sup> May 2010 contained an incorrect date for receipt of objections/comments regarding the proposals. In addition to correction of the dates for the statutory notice period this second Notice also names Ridgeons Group Ltd as a business partner to the Trust.**

The proposed alteration is to change category from a community school to a foundation school and to acquire a foundation established otherwise than under the School Standards and Framework Act 1998 from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2010.

It is proposed that the foundation will be called The North Cambridge Community Trust and that the membership will include: Manor Community College, Cambridgeshire County Council, Cambridgeshire Constabulary, Kings Hedges Neighbourhood Partnership, Cambridge University Press, Cambridge Regional College, Associated Primary Schools Cluster and Ridgeons Group Ltd.

The key purpose of the foundation will be to support the education of students at the school and to promote community cohesion by:

- Raising attainment and achievement at the school across the local area through collaborative working.
- Raising the aspirations of children and young people in the Arbury, East Chesterton and Kings Hedges areas of Cambridge.
- Fostering an ethos of continuing education and improvement and a culture of excellence.
- Enhancing leadership and promoting continuing educational and professional development through partnership working.

This Notice is a summary of the full statutory proposals.
